PREMS fieldwork officially closed on 18 April 2023 with a **response rate of 37%.** This equates to **6,616 stroke survivors having responded to the survey** via post or online to share their experience of stroke care with us.

This excellent response rate for a first-time stroke survey has been welcomed as a demonstration of the stroke survivor's desire to share their experiences.
